The ABYA February meeting was called to order by Commodore Ed Bolsendahl at 7:30pm on Monday February 6th at the FOE Eagles on Greater Mack in St Clair Shores. A motion passed to suspend the July meeting indefinitely as it historically conflicts with most delegates' schedules and results in low attendance. It was brought up that a bill is being put before the state legislature to eliminate bottomland leases for private citizens and clubs and reduce the leases for commercial marinas... more to follow as information becomes available.
